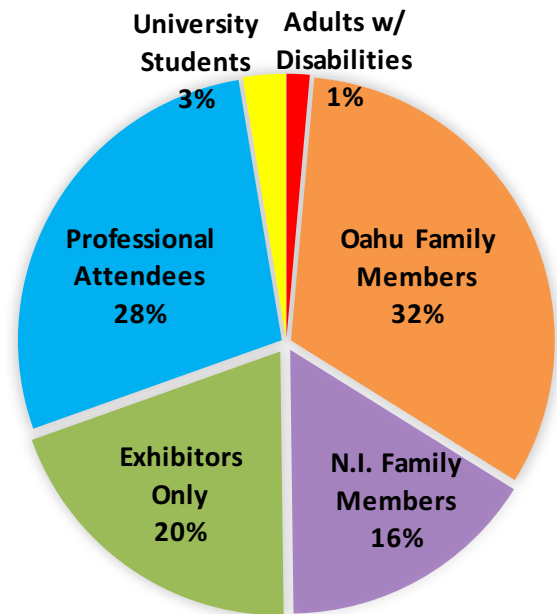

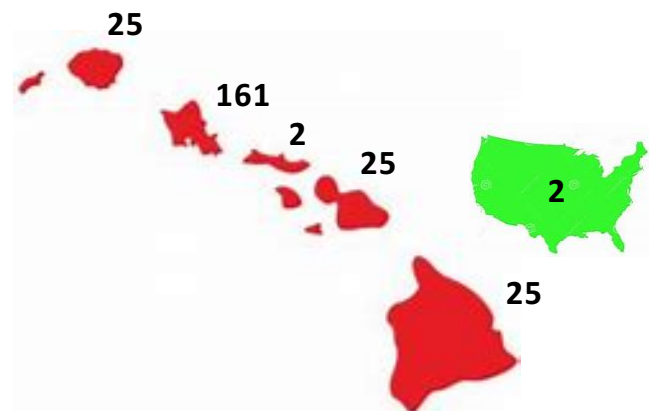

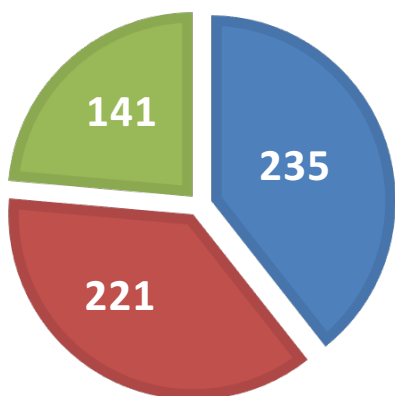


FAMILY ATTENDANCE BY ISLAND

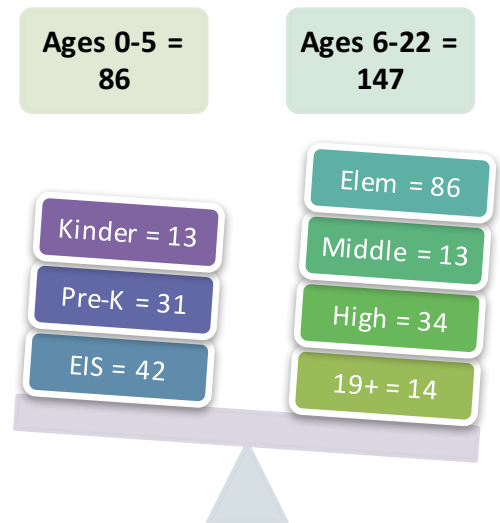

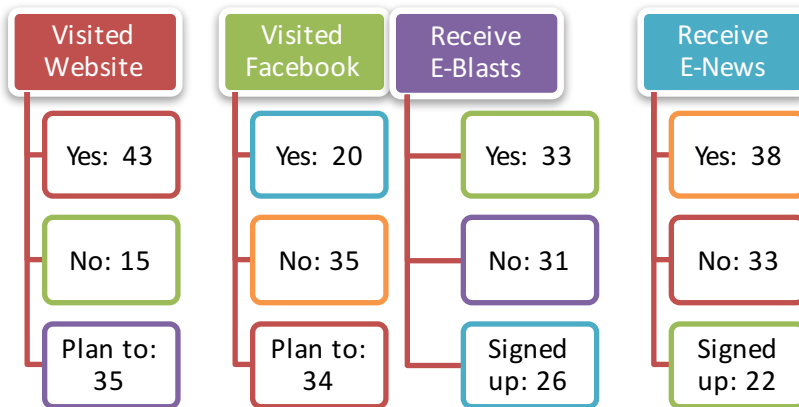

AGES OF CHILDREN REPRESENTED



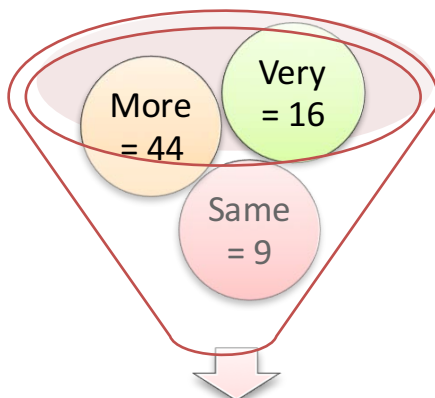

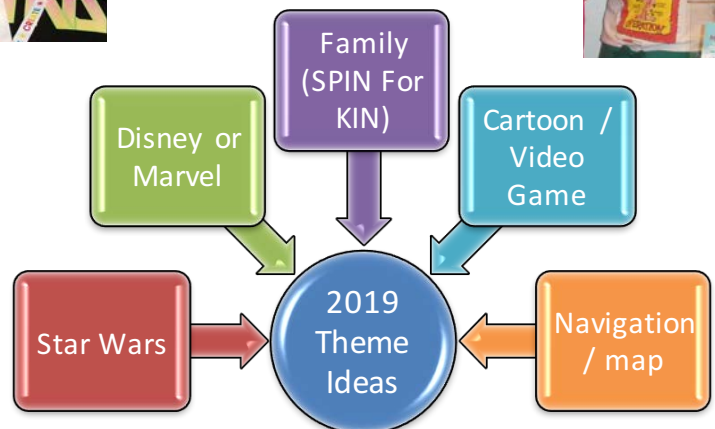
- How-to for policy/Legislature
