**PRIVATE SCHOOL PARTICIPATION PROJECT (PSPP)  
PROJECT DESCRIPTION, Preschool-Grade 12**

**School Year (SY) 2020-2021**

The PSPP is available to students who have been identified with a disability under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and have been voluntarily enrolled by their parent(s)/legal guardian(s) in a private school. Described below are the PSPP priorities and services available to eligible students in Preschool-Grade 12 and for private school personnel supporting PSPP students.

*Students must demonstrate a need (documented in the Services Plan) in a specific area in order to qualify for PSPP services within that particular area.*

Tutoring	Reading	The maximum amount is <u>only</u> one (1) hour of tutoring per week. The one (1) hour can focus on one (1) or more priority area(s).
